

Competitive capacity of administrative and legal practices as a key factor in the foreign economic activity of China: lessons for innovative development of Russia under conditions of WTO

Key approaches undertaken by China's leadership to enhancing the competitiveness of Chinese enterprises and to stimulating their innovative development under WTO conditions are analyzed.
